

HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

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MEASURE BY MATCHING YOUR CURRENT RING:

- 1. Choose a ring you currently own (or have borrowed, if this is a surprise engagement or a gift) that fits the finger you intend to wear your Robert Alton ring on.
- 2. Match your ring with the circle that most closely matches its size, ensuring the inner edge of your ring aligns with the outer edge of the circle.
- 3. This number represents the inside circumference of your ring.

 If your ring falls between two sizes, we recommend selecting the larger size.



MEASURE YOUR FINGER WITH PAPER SIZER:



Carefully cut along the sizer's outline. Then, make a small slit on the line at the left end of the sizer.



Wrap the sizer around the intended finger with the numbers facing outward.



Slide the sizer to the widest part of the finger and pull it tightly. The sizer must fit snugly to ensure an accurate measurement.



The number that aligns with the slit indicates the ring size for that finger.
